Solar Rooftops Save up to \$12,000

LADWP created Solar Rooftops to help homeowners install solar panel systems on their rooftops. LADWP will install, connect and maintain a solar panel system, and either issue the customer an annual check of up to \$600, or a monthly bill credit; the agreement is valid for 20 years and can save you up to \$12,000. There are no upfront costs, annual fees, credit checks or maintenance costs for program participants.

How does the program work?

After a customer signs up for Solar Rooftops, LADWP will inspect the home to ensure eligibility. An inspection is needed to ensure that the roof can support the solar panel system, and that there are no shading issues from nearby structures. After passing inspection, LADWP will build and own a solar panel system between 1-10 kilowatts (kW) on the customer's rooftop.

This process includes designing the solar panel system package and pulling a permit from the LA Department of Building and Safety (LADBS). After LADBS inspects and approves the installed system, it will be connected to LADWP's electric grid and LADWP will receive the energy generated. The customer will receive a check or bill credit as payment for the use of the rooftop, regardless of the amount of solar energy produced from the system.

The program is open to residential LADWP electrical customers who meet the following qualifications:

- · Located in the LA area
- Have a residential rate schedule (R1A, R1B, R1D or R1E)
- · Live in an owner-occupied home
- Have a single family home with composite shingles.
- · Meet LADWP's evaluation and criteria found online
